## COACHING STAFF

All members of the coaching staff have experience with hockey, both playing and coaching. They are carefully selected for their knowledge and ability to work with young athletes with disabilities.

Each of the twelve permanent coaches is certified through USA Hockey's Coaching Education Program (CEP).



Weekly practices are on Sundays from October through April. An international tournament held in the spring, alternates between Canadian and U.S. hosts.

A player may join at any time during the season. Three teams, beginning, intermediate, and advanced, allow for different levels of experience and ensure individual attention. Equipment and small scholarships are available.
